

The Roger Williams Legacy Programme



Professor Roger Williams CBE, 1931 - 2020

The Foundation for Liver Research will honour the life and work of the late Professor Roger Williams, CBE, by funding a programme of work to celebrate his contributions to Hepatology, focusing on 4 key areas which reflect his interests and remarkable career

- ❖ **Clinical Fellowship:** based at King's College Hospital, a single Fellowship will be awarded every 2 years for a 12-18 month period of work. The award will cover salary (in conjunction with clinical sessions at KCH) and a consumable budget
- ❖ **PhD Studentships:** 2 studentships will be awarded annually to students registering with King's College London and based at The Roger Williams Institute of Hepatology. The 3yr studentships will cover fees, stipend and a consumables budget
- ❖ **Small Grants Scheme:** an annual award, either in the form of 2 grants of £20,000 or a single award of £40,000, open to all UK hepatologists and scientists
- ❖ **Policy work to improve liver health in the UK:** building on the work of the Lancet Commission into Liver Disease in the UK, a joint programme of work with the British Liver Trust
